

2 Man Modified Alternate Shot Tournament Format and Handicap

The 2 Man Modified Alternate Shot procedure is as follows:

- Each player tees off.
- The team selects the ball they want to play.
- The players balls that was not selected is will hit the next shot from the location of the ball selected and players will alternate shots going forward until the ball is holed.
- The procedure is repeated on the next hole with both players hitting a tee shot and restarting the process.

Handicap Allocation

The team handicap is be determined using the following procedure.

- The course handicap for each player is determined,
- The course handicaps are added together,
- The total of the players course handicaps divided by two.
- As an example
 - o Player A course handicap is 8
 - o Player B course handicap is 12
 - Total of two (8 + 12) = 20
 - \circ Team handicap (20/2) = 10
