



OPTIONAL INDIVIDUAL SKINS GAME

During the 2022 season you will have the option to play an individual skins game. Initially an optional skins game will be available on days that the MGA tournament is a \$10 individual stroke play tournament. There are 7 of these tournaments scheduled in 2022. Depending on the popularity of the optional skins game it could be expanded to more days.

Below are the requirements for playing in the optional skins game.

- To participate you must be playing in the individual stroke play tournament. You cannot just play in the skins game and not play in the regular MGA tournament.
- The optional skins game will be a cash entry fee (cannot be charged to your club account)
- Buy-in for the skins game will be \$5 and must be paid before the start of play.
- There will be a skins buy-in table outside the golf shop or in the outpost where MGA members will be collecting the skins buy-in.
- All payouts will be in cash.
- Scoring will be done after the conclusion of the tournament in the Ball room. Since we will not know the field until play starts, we will not be able to setup the skins game in Golf Genius in advance of play. The same scorecard will be used for both the regular tournament and the skins game.
- The Skins game format will be as follows:
 - The game will be basic net skins with each player getting their full handicap where ever they fall. A net skin will tie a gross skin in this format.
 - The field will be flighted with the maximum number of 12 players per flight. Accordingly with a full flight the skins pool would be \$60 per flight. The pool will be divided by the number of skins won per flight to determine payout. If 20 players get into the skins game there would be two flights of 10 each.
 - After computation of the amount won by a player the amount will be rounded to the nearest \$. For example, if skins are worth \$10.40 each and a player wins 2 skins, they will collect \$21. ($10.40 \times 2 = 20.80$) rounded to \$21. If a player wins one skin, they would collect \$10. Any dollars left over after rounding will be given to the wait staff.
- Heritage Cup Points will not be awarded for winning skins. The MGA 18 Tournament Committee and the MGA Board may revisit this depending on popularity of the optional skins game. If a change is made to award Heritage Cup Points it would be retroactive.
