



## Quota Tournaments Individual Quota Scoring

Each player is assigned a quota which is determined by subtracting their course handicap from 36. For example, a player with a course handicap of 10 will have a quota of 26 (36-10).

Each player plays their own ball and records their **Gross Score** and receives points based on the following schedule. In the format once the best score you make is a gross triple bogey the player should pick and record the triple bogey on the scorecard.

### Quota Point Schedule

- Hole in One 10 pts
- Double Eagle 8 pts
- Eagle 6 pts
- Birdie 4 pts
- Par 2 pts
- Bogey 1 pts
- Double Bogey 0 pts
- Triple or higher -1 pts

### Scoring

Player with a course handicap of 10, with a quota of 26 (36-10).

Player accumulates 27 points over 18 holes and is therefore +1 (27-26)
