



MGA 9 CHA-CHA TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Each member of a three man or four-man team will hit his own ball throughout the round beginning on the 10th hole

If you are on a three-man team the golf genius system will assign the blind as the fourth team member

The CHA-CHA format considers a team members handicap for scoring. Just enter each team member's gross score per hole.

The pro shop will enter each team members gross score into the Golf Genius system. The golf genius systems will calculate each team member's net score per hole.

It will then select the best net score or scores based on the following schedule:

- Hole 10 – One net score
- Hole 11 – Two net scores
- Hole 12 – Three net scores
- Hole 13 – One net score
- Hole 14 – Two net scores
- Hole 15 – Three net scores
- Hole 16 – One net score
- Hole 17 – Two net scores
- Hole 18 – Three net scores

The system will then add the net score for all holes together in order to determine a team score. And finally, it will identify the first, second, and third place teams, and the last place team.

A breakfast ball on the first tee Only is allowed and two anytime mulligans may be used for this format.

If you take a breakfast ball or a Mulligan, those are the balls in play, you do not get to choose between the shots you hit.
