FLIGHTING AND PAYOUT GUIDELINES FOR 2023 TOURNAMENTS GUIDELINES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE

The descriptions below explain how the tournament flights and payouts will be determined in 2023. The flighting and payout rules are unique to the type of tournament as set forth in the headings below.

These rules will not apply to the certain tournaments which are the two-day member-member tournaments, match play, MGA Club Championship and Heritage Cup. The tournament committees for each of these events will control the flighting and payout.

The MGA 18 Tournament Committee reserves the right to modify the flighting and payout rules if circumstances necessitate a modification.

Individual Stroke Play Tournaments – Paying Gross & Net

This will be used for all individual stroke play tournaments.

We will pay three places for gross and net in each flight with the purse split as follows:

First Place	50%
Second Place	30%
Third Place	20%

The number of flights will be determined by the number of participants, as set forth in the table below.

Number of Players	# Of Flights
Up to 16 Players	1
17 to 32 Players	2
33 to 48 Players	3
49 to 64 Players	4
65 to 80 Players	5

Individual Quota Tournaments - Paying best to Quota

The following will be used for all individual Quota tournaments.

Since the winners by flight are determine by points to their computed quota there is no net and gross. We pay four places in each flight with the purse split as follows:

First Place	35%
Second Place	27%
Third Place	22%
Fourth Place	16%

The number of flights will be determined by the number of participants, below is the flight ranges.

Number of Players	# Of Flights
Up to 12 Players	1
13 to 24 Players	2
25 to 36 Players	3
37 to 48 Players	4
49 to 60 Players	5
61 to 72 Players	6

2 Man Team Quota – Paying best to Quota

This will be used for all 2 Man Team Quota tournaments that because of the format we will only be paying one score such as a scramble or Individual Quota formats. We pay four places in each flight with the purse split as follows:

First Place	35%
Second Place	30%
Third Place	20%
Fourth Place	15%

The number of flights will be determined by the number of participants, as set forth in the table below.

Number of Players	# Of Flights
Up to 30 Players	1
31 to 60 Players	2
61 and over Players	3

2 Man Team Best Ball & Scramble – Gross & Net

This will be used for all 2 Man Team best ball and scramble tournaments.

We will pay three places for gross and net in each flight with the purse split as follows:

First Place	42%
Second Place	33%
Third Place	25%

The number of flights will be determined by the number of participants, as set forth in the table below.

Number of Players	# Of Flights
Up to 30 Players	1
31 to 52 Players	2
53 to70 Players	3
71 And over Players	4

4 Man Team Quota – Paying best to Quota

This will be used for all 4 Man Team Quota tournaments that because of the format we will only be paying one score such as a scramble or Individual Quota formats. We pay three places in each flight with the purse split as follows:

First Place	50%
Second Place	30%
Third Place	20%

The number of flights will be determined by the number of participants, as set forth in the table below.

29 to 56 Players	2
57 and over Players	3
