

Purpose

Rewards consistent play in Thursday tournaments, Match Play, Member/Member (pick your partner) and the Club Championship.

Qualifiers Point

system

Top 60 point-earners qualify to play in the Heritage Cup net tournament.

Points Awarded

Team Competitions	Individual Competitions
$1^{st} - 4$ points	$1^{st} - 8$ points
$2^{nd} - 3$ points	$2^{nd} - 6$ points
$3^{rd} - 2$ points	3^{rd} – 4 points
4^{th} – 1 points	4^{th} – 2 Points

Points will be allocated only to teams or individuals receiving money rewards.

Member-Member (pick your partner), Member-Member Blind Draw and the Club Championship = 2 Additional points for each place.

Match Play: Special point allocations. (see separate schedule)

"Reset" points based on order of finish

"Final" points + "Reset" points = Winner of the Heritage Cup



HISTORY

The Heritage Cup was introduced in 2015 by the MGA Board. It was patterned after the PGA Tour's FedEx Cup, and its intent was to recognize members who consistently participate and perform well in weekly tournaments. A point system was adopted which recognized performance in the tournaments. Players' total points for the season ranked them from 1 to 60 and qualified them for the HC final tournament to determine the Heritage Cup Champion.

The system has worked well. In the past 7 years the Heritage Cup winners have come from a wide spectrum of playing abilities but the results indicate that success in the Heritage Cup comes only from consistent participation and performance.

CHANGES

For 2021 and beyond, in order to further improve the competition, the MGA Board has decided to modify the process in keeping with the recent improvements made to the FedEx Cup. Instead of using a reset points system for the final tournament players will be assigned a starting score to Par based upon their order of finish in total points at the end of the regular season. The table below shows the starting scores to Par allocated to the 60 qualifying players.

The following illustrates the how the scoring will be done for the Heritage Cup Championship Tournament.

Sum of

Starting Score (72 minus starting score to par from above based on final HC Point Position) + Round 1 Net Score

+ Round 2 Net Score

Sum of the above equals Final Heritage Cup Championship Score

As a result of this change, the winner of the final tournament will automatically become the HC champion.

Prize Pool Payout

For 2022 all qualifiers that play in the Heritage Cup Tournament will receive a payout from the prize fund. The following examples illustrates the payout assuming 100% participation and participation level of 70% or 42 players.
